

Open Enrollment Application Period Nears for 2013 - 2014 Public Schools

Wisconsin's Public School Open Enrollment program allows parents to apply for their children to attend school districts other than the one in which they live. All schools will be hosting an open house on Thursday, January 24, 2013 from 6:00-7:30 p.m. to welcome non-resident families into our schools.

If you know families outside of the Howard-Suamico School District who would like their children to attend our schools, the application period for the 2013-14 school year is February 4 through April 30, 2013. 4K (4-Year-Old Kindergarten):

Registration for children who will be age four on or before September 1, 2013 will be available online or walk-in registration at Lineville Intermediate School on **February 1**, **2013 from 7:30 am – 4:00 p.m**. Beginning **February 2**, **2013**, you may register your child at any of the elementary schools if you do not have access to a computer to register online or could not register in person on February 1. Please bring your child's birth certificate, immunization records and proof of residency i.e. utility bill with resident address to complete the registration. The other forms needed are available online(Health History & Emergency Plan, Immunization form with record attached, and the DPI Child Health Report). School hours **are 8:00 a.m.** – **3:30 p.m.** Monday through Friday. 4K and will be five on or before September 1, 2013 will take place at all elementary schools on February 21 & 26 from 7:30

a.m. - 4:00 p.m. New families will need to bring the child's birth certificate, immunization records and proof of residency i.e.

or you may call to request a Kindergarten Registration packet. If anyone has questions about registration, they should contact the

District Office at 662-7713 or any of our elementary schools.

If you are applying for open enrollment, (families who do not live in Howard or Suamico) please note that the 2012-13 open enrollment application period is February 4 – April 30, 2013.
