A Message from the Principal,

Good Afternoon,

It's the halfway mark of the school year....already! This is a busy time of year for grades, reporting, and best of all for **REFLECTING**. The way we learn is by doing and reflecting on what has been done. Students will be undergoing all sorts of reflection activities in the upcoming weeks to help them continue to better understand themselves as learners and to set specific goals for the next part of the year.

Report Cards

On Friday at 6:00 you will receive a message that you can access report cards in PowerSchool. Teachers have been putting in a lot of time entering information into this reporting system so that you have another opportunity to better understand where your child is at in a specific standard area. As a reminder, each standard is written with the goal that the child attains it by the end of the year. Our 4, 3, 2, 1 grading system is written for a progressional and applicable purpose. A "1" simply means that the student needs a lot of help to do the work expected and is not able to do it on their own and/or may still not show an understanding. A "2" means a student is growing in knowledge and independence, but still needs help at times or misses the complete understanding. A "3" shows that a student has a solid understanding of the standard as stated and is able to prove it. A "4" means that the student knows the standard so well, that they are able to apply this understanding in multiple settings that they have created and are able to prove it in unique ways.

Parent-Teacher Conferences

Conferences are February 16th and 21st from 4-7:30. We will again use TEESO to schedule your conferences. More information about that will come out soon. Conferences is yet another opportunity to meet with the

teacher and learn more about your student. Additionally, as part of our work to "Lead your learning", we have begun to include students more in leading part of this process.

Creation Day- No School for students- Friday, February 3rd

As noted in prior communications, by adding 5 minutes to each school day, we were able to provide teachers with three full days of professional development during the school year. The goal of the "Creation Day" is that our staff has the opportunity to design their own learning paths that meet their unique learning needs. During this day, teachers, administrators and other staff from all of over the district, have opportunities to not only learn but also to present on things they are passionate about. This day is focused on transforming teaching practices and that is exactly what it is doing. We have teachers also taking classes during nights, weekends and in the summer. We believe that by modeling the way with our learning, students see that learning never stops and that it is meant to make us better.

- Select InfoSnap Year Round Update on the left side under navigation. (This will take a couple seconds to populate the information that is currently in PowerSchool.)
