School Store Volunteers Wanted!

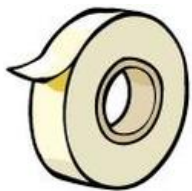
Dear Parents and Guardians,

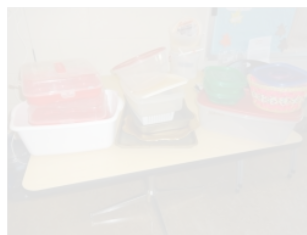
