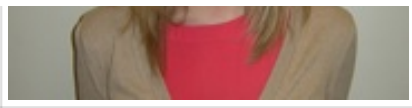
### **Celebrating the Winter Olympics**

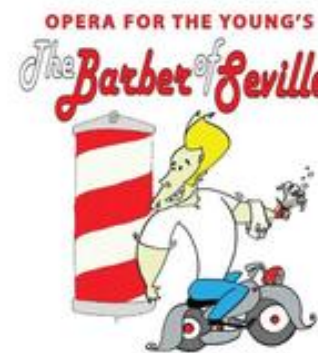

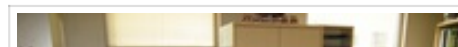
## 4th Grade classes are going to MADISON-Thursday, June 5th, 2014
