

4K and 5K Registration Nearing!

4K Registration:

Registration for **4K** is available online at www.hssd.k12.wi.us/4K beginning **February 3** for children who will be age four on or before September 1, 2014. As soon as you complete the online registration form, the system will send you a confirmation e-mail telling you to verify

certain documents and complete additional state required forms. If you do not have access to a computer, staff will be available at Lineville Intermediate School to assist you on February 3 with registering your child during the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. If you do not have access to a computer to complete the online application, you may register your child at any of the elementary schools in their office area beginning February 4, 2014. In addition, please bring verification documents to the elementary school to complete the registration process. School hours are 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Kindergarten Registration:

If your child currently attends the Howard & Suamico 4K program, they are already accepted and enrolled in the Howard-Suamico School District and we welcome you to continue their education with us.

Registration for children who **did not attend the Howard & Suamico 4K** and will be age five on or before September 1, 2014 will take place at all elementary schools on **February 20** from 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and **February 25** from 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. for the 2014-2015 kindergarten class
