

Registration for **4K** is available online at www.hssd.k12.wi.us/4K beginning for children who will be age four on or before September 1, 2014. As soon as you complete the online registration form, the system will send you a confirmation e-mail telling you to verify certain documents and complete additional state required forms.

If you do not have access to a computer to complete the online application, you may register your child at any of the elementary schools in their office area beginning February 4, 2014. In addition, please bring verification documents (birth certificate and proof of residency) to the elementary school to complete the registration process. School hours are 8:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
