Cash, check, Visa, or MasterCard accepted at registration. **Class close when they are full.** Once registered, parent/guardian will receive an email confirmation of class and payment information.

Registration Tips - A new family account needs to be created each year (1 per household). Family username and passwords are created by the user. Passwords must contain a minimum of six characters and include a number. When registration is accepted and payment is approved, email confirmations will be sent for EACH class.

Location of Classes

Bay Port - High school classes, driver's education, enrichment, resource, music, sports, and swim classes, etc.

Lineville – Certified safety classes, music and sports classes.

Forest Glen – Off to Kindergarten. June 22 – July 2; July 13 – July 24.

Fees - Online payments can be made using Visa or MasterCard. Residents: \$10 per class (fees vary depending on the type of course). Non-residents: \$75 per class.

Deadline - As classes fill up, they will be closed. Register early as all classes have enrollment caps and will quickly fill up. There is no wait list for classes.
