As part of our 3rd grade Immigration Unit, all third grade students will be immigrating to the United States through Ellis Island. We are setting up a model of Ellis Island in the Library Media Center. This is the eighth year we have performed this Quest, and <u>we need</u> your volunteer help!!

We are asking Moms, Dads and others in our community to help us with this program. Would you be available on **Tuesday**, **March 18, from 8:30 a.m.-11:15 a.m. to help** with the Ellis Island Quest? You will be one of the "investigators" on Ellis Island that poses questions to the students and checks over their papers to be certain they have proper identification. We want to be certain that these new immigrant families do not carry disease, and that they have a sponsor or a job that would be beneficial to the United States. (Your parts are scripted.)
