Volunteer Application/Background Check Process has been streamlined

The registration process for getting approved to volunteer has been streamlined. All volunteer applications need to be completed online in our volunteer program, **Better Impact**. Background checks will also be completed online at the BIB (Background Investigation Bureau) web site. No more paperwork to shuffle! This provides a secure environment for your information.

If you are planning to volunteer at school or go on a field trip, please register in **Better Impact** by March 31st. Registration directions are on the district website under the Community tab, Volunteer Program (or **click here** for directions). The link to the background check web site will be
