#### A Message from the Principal...

Good Afternoon Sailor Families,

With spring drawing near, it is a good time of year to review some key safety details and managerial items. The below items are some of the top concerns:

- Please do not drop off students prior to 8:30am UNLESS they are going to breakfast which starts at 8:20. There is a growing amount of students showing up at 8:10, 8:15 and so on. There is no scheduled supervision for students at this time. We do have a CHAMPIONS before school care program in the event it is not consistently possible to drop off at 8:30.
