4K (4-Year-Old Kindergarten): Registration for children who will be age four on or before September 1, 2013 is available online or you may register your child at any of the elementary schools if you do not have access to a computer. Please bring your child's birth certificate, immunization records and proof of residency i.e. utility bill with resident address to complete the registration. The other forms needed are available online(Health History & Emergency Plan, Immunization form with record attached, and the DPI Child Health Report). School hours are 8:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.
