On Wednesday, March 14th, students in 4th grade will visit Lineville

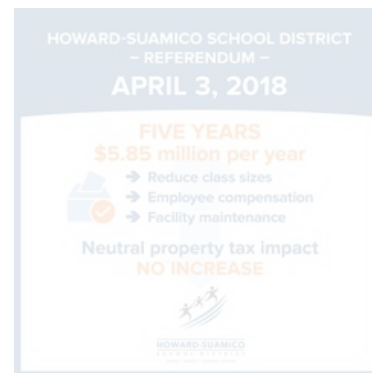
