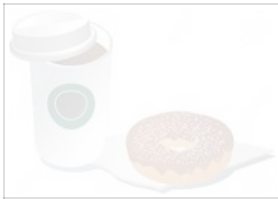

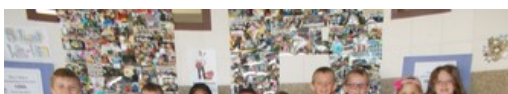


## Sailor Pride Ticket Drawing Winners

### Secretary

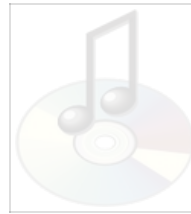

## PLANNED ABSENCE FORM
