This is my last issue of "Counselor's Cove" for this year....I want to express my gratitude to all of our amazing students, families, and staff for so graciously welcoming me to Bay Harbor this year. Being here for the last 5 months has been an absolute pleasure....I have truly enjoyed working with your children and am excited for what next year will bring at Bay Harbor.

We ended our year in Lifeskills class reviewing Protective Behaviors. With summer right around the corner, it is so critical to review basic safety with your children. Students did an awesome job helping each other remember various aspects of water, bike, stranger, home, and sports safety. In 2nd and 3rd grade, we also reviewed the "Swimsuit Rule" which focuses on the fact that our bodies belong to us and no one should ever make us feel uncomfortable in any way related to our bodies, with the exception of trusted adults helping us stay clean and healthy, like doctors and parents. I also found out that many students did not know their home address or a phone number to reach a parent, so that is another very important thing to discuss at home in the event of an emergency. The motto learned was, "Check first before you go anywhere with anyone, and if you can't check first, the answer is no"!
