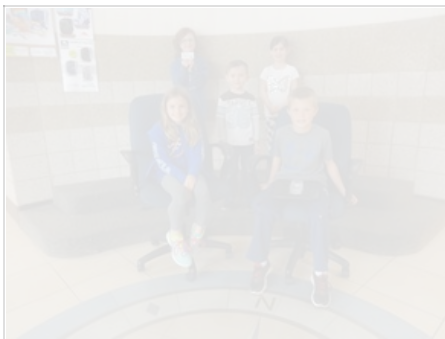


Sailor Pride Ticket Drawing Winners

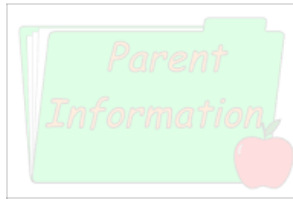
