PLANNED ABSENCE FORM

All absences from school, not related to an illness, injury or family emergency, must be requested in writing at least 48 hours in advance in order for the absence to be excused (family vacation for example). Please complete the **Advance Absence Notice** for this purpose and return to school. This form will be routed to the student's teachers for approval signatures.
