

NFL Pass, Punt & Kick



Bay Harbor will be holding its sixth annual NFL Pass, Punt & Kick competition! The event will be completed during your child's scheduled physical education class throughout the week of September 16th.

All boys and girls ages 6 and up are eligible to participate.

Each Student will be given one pass, one punt and one kick off a football tee during the contest. All three scores will be combined for a total distance. Distance and Accuracy are important! There will be 1st - 3rd place winners in each category (6/7 Boys, 6/7 Girls, 8/9 Boys, 8/9 Girls, 10/11 Boys, 10/11 Girls).
