Morning Drop Off Reminders:


Students may enter the building as early as 8:15 if they are having breakfast, or 8:25 when the first bell rings. School officially begins at 8:35. PLEASE be sure to not bring kids to school earlier than this as we do not have supervision for them. **The end of the day bell rings at 3:30.**


If at any point you are coming into the building with or without your child, please be sure to park your car in a marked parking spot. We cannot leave vehicles unattended in the front of the school...even for a short time. Lastly, when dropping off, please enter only in the east driveway (not near our school sign) and that KIDS LEAVE OUT THE PASSENGER SIDE and onto the sidewalk. Please work to keep traffic moving by having students prepared to exit the vehicle. If you are parking in the lot, please enter the driveway nearest our front sign. Please be sure to walk your child across the crosswalk and be aware of all traffic. No students

should be dropped off in the parking lot to walk across by themselves. On another note, all of our students have the ability to take the bus. To reduce traffic before and after school, this may be an option you want to look at. It seems like our pick-up numbers have doubled since last year and it is in no plan to expand parking.

Last year Bay Harbor collect 739 pounds of food items! Our 4th grade will be volunteering at the Giving Tree on Oct 31.



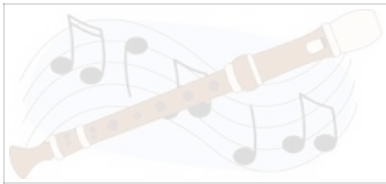
Bay Harbor 4th graders will be volunteering at the "Feed My Starving Children" mobile packing meal event on Oct. 8th.

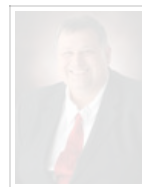

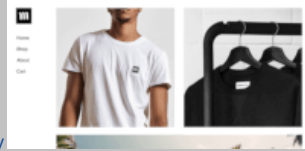
