At the end of October our 4th graders will visit the Giving Tree. They will see first hand how the pantry operates. Students will also be educated on poverty and how it is affecting children and families.

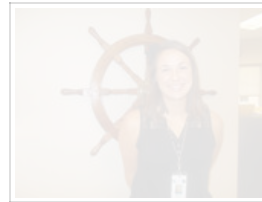

Please complete the **Advance Absence Notice** for this purpose and return to school. This form will be routed to the student's teachers for approval signatures.
