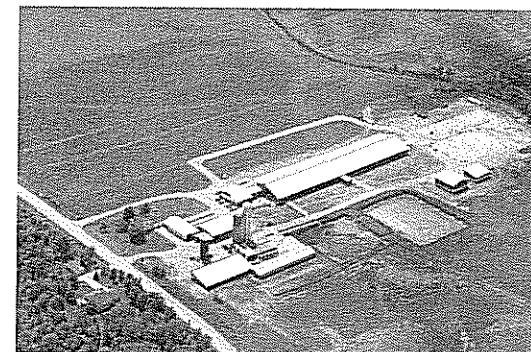

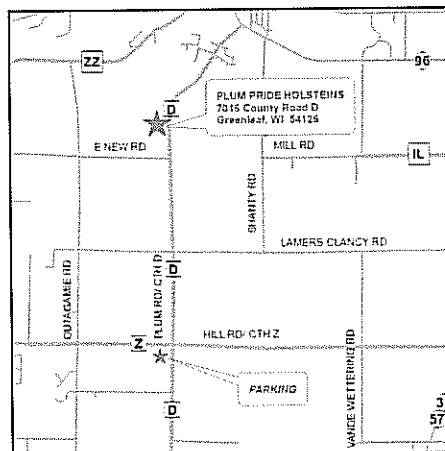
Plum Pride Holsteins ♦ 7016 County Rd. D ♦ Greenleaf

The farm is located just south of Wrightstown on Plum Rd./County D (some GPS devices will bring you to the wrong County D). Watch for signs; both sets of directions will have you turn south on Plum Rd./County D by Wrightstown High School.

From West of Green Bay: Travel on Hwy. 41 towards Wrightstown. Take Exit 154 (County U) towards Wrightstown. Continue on S. County Line Rd. Take Broadway St. to Plum Rd./County D in Wrightstown.

From East of Green Bay: Travel to Wrightstown on Hwy. 96 or 57. Follow WI-96 west to Plum Rd./County D. Go south (left) on Plum Rd./County D to farm.

PARKING: No parking is allowed on Plum Rd./County D. Parking is located on the corner of County D & Z (3 miles south of the farm). A shuttle service will take you from the parking area to the farm.



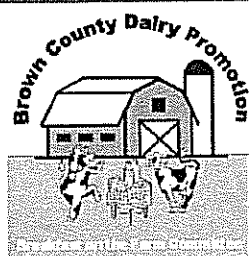

Welcome to Plum Pride Holsteins!

Plum Pride Holsteins is proud to host this year's Breakfast on the Farm! We are Marv and Patty Biese, and have three children—Katie (13), Kyle (11), and Kevin (9).

Marv became partner with his parents right after he graduated from high school, and he took over full ownership of the farm in January 1999. At that time, he was milking around 100 cows.

In February 2010, we had a barn fire that destroyed the old two-story barn. We rebuilt a new and updated barn and starting milking again in October 2010. In the summer of 2014, we expanded to our current size; we are milking around 500 cows and have seven employees.



In hopes of promoting the dairy industry and all it contributes to our economy and the importance of consuming dairy products, our objective is to attract urban families to the farm to see how a dairy operation works. All proceeds from this event are used to provide free agriculture education programs to students in Brown County schools and the community.
